

Potential out of hours works

WSI Cargo Precinct

October 2024 – end February 2025

Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport (WSI) will be Sydney's first 24 hour domestic, international and cargo airport. Opening in late 2026, WSI will cater to 10 million passengers a year, eventually growing to become Australia's primary gateway.

The WSI Cargo Precinct will increase Sydney's air cargo capacity by around 33 per cent upon opening and provide dedicated access via the upgraded Northern Road and proximity to growing freight and logistics centres at Kemps Creek and the Aerotropolis.

Potential out of hours works

Our Cargo Precinct contractor, CPB ACCIONA Joint Venture, may need to carry out some earthworks on the roundabout area in the precinct (parallel to The Northern Road) outside of standard construction hours (i.e. Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 1pm).

The out of hours works (OOHW) will only be used in the event of delays to the construction program because of unplanned issues like poor weather.

If this is the case, work will be carried out during the extended hours of Monday to Friday (5am to 8pm) and Saturday (6am to 6pm).

Our contractor will be required to carry out noise monitoring in the times outside of standard construction hours. Normal dust suppression measures will continue to be applied.
