Notification of Flight Test



Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton)
Airport (WSI) will undertake an operational flight test using a small twin engine aircraft on 2 October 2024. It's being completed by ADB Safegate – a subcontractor of WSI's Airside Civil and Pavement Works (ACP) contractor, the CPB ACCIONA Joint Venture.

The contractor is undertaking this flight test as part of the commissioning requirements to test the 3000 Aeronautical Ground Lights (AGL's) that have been installed in our runway and taxiways.

The flight test is scheduled to take place between midday and midnight on Wednesday 2 October 2024.



FAQs

Why is the flight test extending over a 12-hour period?

To rigorously test our Aeronautical Ground Lights, we need to conduct flight checks in a number of conditions; daylight, dusk/twilight, and night.

How will other pilots know about the flight test?

WSI, and the contractor have notified local industry groups and surrounding airfields of the flight test.

The Australian Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) will also issue a NOTAM, which is a notice to alert pilots of potential activities or hazards along a flight route or at a location that could affect the safety of the flight.

What type of plane will it be?

The small plane that will be utilised for the flight test will be a PA-30 Twin Engine Comanche.

Will there be more operational flight tests?

These flight tests are designed to test the 3000 Aeronautical Ground Lights on the WSI runway.

We don't have any further flight tests programmed at this time but will keep you updated on any further activities.

We will continue to keep you updated as we deliver Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.
