WSI Cargo Precinct Asphalt Placement

February 2025 – May 2025

Dear Neighbour,

Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport has engaged CPB ACCIONA Joint Venture to develop its Cargo Precinct. Following our notification in October 2024, for earthworks in the roundabout area (parallel to The Northern Road), we are continuing works and will commence asphaltting activities outside of our standard construction hours.

When will work commence?

Works will commence in late February 2025 and continue until May 2025; they are required to take place outside of construction hours to minimise the impact to construction taking place in the same areas during the day. Our contractor will be required to carry out noise monitoring during works outside of standard construction hours.

Monday to Friday: 6pm – 6am

Saturday and Sunday: 6am – 6pm

How is asphalt made?

Asphalt is a perishable material as it needs to be placed while hot. Producing asphalt involves combining aggregates such as sand and/or crushed rock in a rotating drum and removing the moisture by drying the materials at temperatures between 150 and 180 degrees Celsius. The asphalt will then be placed in trucks and taken to the roundabout area for paving.
